INTRODUCTION

Welcome from the Pharmacy Programs Administrator (PPA). We administer, process and pay claims associated with the Community Pharmacy Programs funded under the Seventh Community Pharmacy Agreement (7CPA) as well as the **Take Home Naloxone (THN) Program**.

This Portal User Guide provides a step-by-step process for Authorised Alternative Suppliers (AAS) to register for and submit data for the THN Program.

This user guide describes the following processes:

- Setting up your user account for the PPA Portal
- Registering for a Role
- Linking your Role to an existing Service Provider
- Linking you Role to a new Service Provider
- Registering for the THN Program
- Submitting Individual Supply Claim Data.

Please note only AAS sites located in Western Australia, South Australia and New South Wales can currently participate in the THN Program. Once this changes for other States and Territories, Service Providers will be informed.

PORTAL ESSENTIALS

For best performance, we recommend using the most recent version of the **Google Chrome** browser. Whilst you can successfully submit your registration and data using other browsers, they may not have all the features required to provide you with the best user experience.

The PPA Portal was developed to specifications from the Department of Health to support our role in administering the Community Pharmacy Programs funded under the 7CPA. We believe it is important for you to understand this, as the registration process was designed to meet these strict specifications to ensure account security for users claiming for these programs. The PPA Portal has since been adapted to allow for AAS sites to take part in the THN Program and submit data via the PPA Portal.

- 1) Navigate to the Portal via the website <u>https://app.ppaonline.com.au</u> and select the **Enter** button
- 2) The Pharmacy Programs Administrator (PPA) Portal Login page will display. Click on the **Register as a new user** link



2) A welcome page will display, which will outline the steps for registering and claiming in the PPA Portal that are in this guide. These steps are general, and this guide is more specifically targeted at AAS users of the Portal.

Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the **To begin please register for a Role** link to register

3) The role/s that you hold influence the Programs and Service Providers for which you can register. As the PPA Portal also manages claiming for 7CPA programs, there are many role options available, but to register for the THN Program you must select **Take Home Naloxone Participant** as your role

If the Service Provider (Authorised Alternative Supplier) already has an account in the Portal, you can follow these steps.

- 1) Select the **Registrations** button at the top of your screen
- 2) Then click on the **Select Role** button to the right of your Take Home Naloxone Participant role

5) A new screen will display, asking you for the Main Contact Details. Enter in your preferred contact details for any formal communications. These communications will be sent to the email address you enter. Click on the **Submit** button to complete the registration process

6) A confirmation message will then appear in the top right-hand corner of the screen.

Please note it may take a few days for your registration to be reviewed and approved. You will receive an email notification when it has been processed.




LINK YOUR ROLE TO A NEW SERVICE PROVIDER

A new AAS must be registered as a Service Provider in the PPA Portal before it can be linked to your Role. This must be completed by the Service Provider's **Main Authorised Person** (MAP).

The **Main Authorised Person** is the only person who can:

- Approve other individuals to act on behalf of the Service Provider in terms of registering for programs or submitting claims
- Update information relating to the Service Provider including address details (physical and postal), and contact details.
- Once you have registered your Take Home Naloxone Participant role you will be shown the following screen. You will need to register a new Service Provider by clicking on the Can't find your Service Provider? Register a new one link



2) The following screen will display. The individual registering for the new Service Provider will automatically be delegated as the **Main Authorised Person** (MAP) for that Service Provider. The MAP is the only person for that Service Provider who will be able to approve other users to act on behalf of the Service Provider (e.g. submit a service claim). The MAP is also the only person who is able to update information relating to this Service Provider

Can't find your Service Provider? Register a new one.

As the individual registering a new Service Provider (e.g. pharmacy or business), you agree that you are authorised to bind this Service Provider on behalf of all owners. You will become the Main Authorised Person for the Service Provider. The Main Authorised Person is the only person who can:

- a. Approve other individuals to act on behalf of the Service Provider in terms of registering for programs or submitting claims.
- b. Update information relating to the Service Provider including Bank Account details, Address details (physical and postal), and Contact details.

- 4) A new screen will display, asking you for the Main Contact Details. Enter in your preferred contact details for any formal communications. These communications will be sent to this email address. Click on the **Submit** button to complete the registration process
- 5) A confirmation message will then appear in the top right-hand corner of the screen.

Please note:

- It may take a few days for your registration to be reviewed and approved. You will receive an email notification when it has been approved.
- If you need to be the MAP for a significant number of AAS sites, please complete one Service Provider registration, then email the PPA Support Centre with a list of the other Service Providers you need to register. We will assist you with this process. You should continue the registration process for the first Service Provider (i.e. complete the other steps in this Guide).



REGISTERING FOR THE THN PROGRAM

Once your Service Provider registration is approved by a PPA Support Centre Operator, you will be able to register that Service Provider for the THN Program.

- 1) Once logged in to the PPA Portal, open the **Home** page to display a list of your approved Service Provider(s)
- 2) To Register for the THN Program, click the **Register for New Program** link underneath the name of the Service Provider you are trying to register for the THN Program. *Please note* only the Main Authorised Person (MAP) for the Service Provider can register for new Programs

3) The Program Registration screen will display a list of all programs a Service Provider may register for. AAS Service Providers can only select **Take Home Naloxone**

- 4) The THN Program registration information will be displayed. This is simply a declaration outlining the conditions you must abide by in order to be eligible to participate in the THN Program
- 5) Ensure you carefully read through the THN Program Declaration, then click the **Submit Registration** button at the bottom of the page to continue

To be eligible to participate in the Take Home Naloxone Program, an Approved Alternative Supplier must:
a. Be authorised by the relevant State or Territory health authority to provide naloxone under the Take Home Naloxone Program in accordance with the relevant Commonwealth legislation
b. Agree that your practice trading name and location may be listed on the Department of Health's website and/or provided to participating state health departments for communications relating to the program
c. Agree to provide services in accordance with the Take Home Naloxone Program Rules, available for download from www.ppaonline.com.au
By clicking Submit Registration you confirm that you are authorised to bind the organisation to abide by the terms and conditions detailed above.

6) Once submitted, the Program Registration will be automatically approved. A green message box will appear in the top right-hand corner of the screen. You can now begin to submit data under the THN Program

SUBMITTING INDIVIDUAL SUPPLY CLAIM DATA

This section details how to submit **Individual Supply Claim** Data through the PPA Portal. The **Individual Supply Claim** asks you to provide information about each instance naloxone was supplied to an individual.

Please note: Although the term "claim" is used throughout this section, AAS are not eligible to receive payment for the supply of Naloxone products. As the PPA Portal was specifically designed for use by other types of organisations (such as pharmacies) as a claiming platform in relation to a range of other programs, this terminology has been retained.

In order to submit a THN Individual Supply Claim you must first submit a Program Registration as per the steps in the above section.

- 1) Once logged into the PPA Portal, click on the **Home** icon to access a list of approved Program registrations against one or more AAS Service Providers
- 2) Click on the **View** button to submit Individual Supply claim data against the THN Program under the relevant Service Provider

4) The **THN Individual Supply Claim** form will display. Please complete all the required fields. Note that this claim form is to be used both for the initial supply of naloxone and any refill supply of naloxone to the same individual.

Please note that a maximum of two total products supplied to an individual can be entered per claim. An individual may however return and receive naloxone on multiple occasions

5) If there are issues with any of the information entered into the claim form, an error message will appear (see below). Correct any entries where necessary

6) Once you have completed the Individual Supply Claim form and read and agreed to the declaration, click on the **Submit** button to submit the claim. If all fields have been correctly entered, an approval message will appear

Thank you for submitting your claim, theclaim has been automatically validated and is now approved

Please note the payment amount for the claim will always be \$0.00 as AAS do not receive payment for the supply of naloxone under the THN Program.



- 7) If you need to return to the claim at another time, click the **Save** button instead. Saved claims will save with a *Pre-Submission* status
- 8) To see a list of all submitted and/or saved claims, click on the Claims tab. Click on the Continue Submission button to complete any saved claims. Only submitted claims will be accepted. If claims are not submitted, they cannot be accepted.
